### **Host Home**

Host homes are a huge part of the KampOut Ministry. The host home families play an important role by supporting, encouraging, and extending hospitality to the Kanakuk staff while they serve the kids in our community. As a host home you will provide a place to sleep for at least 3 of staff members (bed, mattress, couch), some kind of breakfast every morning of their stay, dinner Monday-Thursday, and access to the washer and dryer so the staff can do their laundry if needed.

### **On site-Health Care Professional**

Kanakuk KampOut has asked that Gashland EPC provides someone or a team of people with some form of medical experience, background, or certification to be on-site Tuesday-Friday from 8:40am-4pm.

### **Meal Team**

Kanakuk KampOut asks Gashland EPC to provide lunch for 30 staff members Tuesday- Friday.

### **Overnight Security Personnel**

Kanakuk KampOut asks that Gashland provides an overnight security personnel who will watch over Kanakuk's equipment from 6:00pm-6:00am Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday night. This is a paid position!

### **Scholarship Partner**

It is our heart that every kid who wants to go to Kanakuk KampOut can go! This is an amazing opportunity for our children and the children in the community to get to know Jesus Christ as the Lord and Savior and grow in their faith.

### **Junior Counselor**

Kanakuk KampOut provides a neat opportunity for Gashland's high school students to be Junior Counselors. Each Jr. Counselor will be paired with one of the staff counselors where they will provide additional support to the staff, work closely with the kids, participate in a Bible study every day with the leadership team members, and learn from the staff counselors they are paired with.
